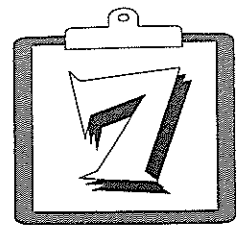

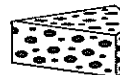


G: Calculating costs
