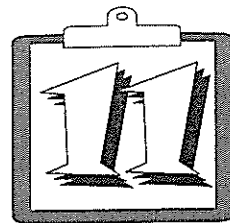

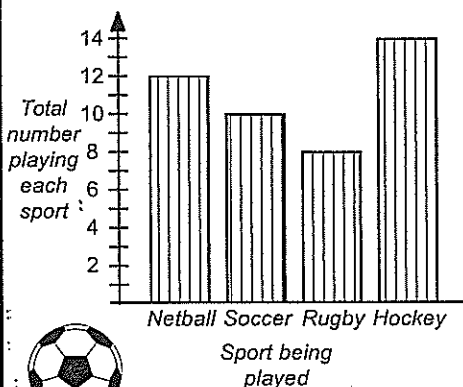
B: Endings for sentences
