- Writing. Wk 6 we concentrated on logging into, and completing learning tasks in the Night Zookeeper. During wk 7 rm 4 wrote an explanation about their space craft.

Our focus is on 'finding the answers to questions', as this shows our understanding of the text. - STEAM / Inquiry. The challenge: To build a spacecraft that could visit te ra. To do this we needed to draw on our knowledge of the sun and use our imagination. We tried not to build a space rocket, as these cannot visit the sun. The first step was to plan, design and label our craft. Next, we made a 3D model. During the end of the week, we wrote an explanation. Here we were able to share our great ideas.
