SCHOOL STRUCTURE:

JUNIORS Year 1-3

"Hands on Programme" This programme has been designed as the result of a great deal of research by Merlyn. Teachers from other schools have come to observe the programme in action so they can create their own version for their schools.

Every student in Years 1&2 will be involved in the programme under the guidance of Merlyn and Helen. All parents of Year 1&2 students will receive a parents guide to the programme in the first week of 2019.

Mrs. Helen Davenport Reception Class

For the first part of the year, when numbers are lower in the junior school, Helen will be able to take students from Years 1&2 who need a little boost to get their learning off to a flying start, for group lessons. She will also be the classroom teacher for all 5 year olds, giving them a great foundation for their start at Hunua School.

Ms. Merlyn Thompson Year 1&2

This class transitions students, getting them ready for year 3. Helping them to understand how to learn, how to become independent learners and to give them little bursts of responsibility.

Mrs. Nola White Year 3 AP (Assistant Principal)

Nola is better known to most as a Year 6 teacher ... she is also a very experienced Junior teacher. Nola has joined the Junior team once again to provide a balance in the Leadership Team, with a leader in each area of the school.

Nola will also be working to spread our Environmental curriculum across the whole school so all students can participate.

MIDDLE Year 4-6

Mrs. Sue Acton & Mrs. Sally Wood Year 4&5

This year group is the bridge for students from the Junior area of the school. The older students are great guides for the younger ones. They will also have opportunity to extend themselves and their learning.

There will be times when the two year levels work apart. These are age related and mainly revolve around competition.

At these times Year 4 is judged with the juniors and Year 5 are judged with Year 6 e.g. poetry recitals, speeches, Ag Day activities, swimming sports, and some ECCS fun days.

(ECCS = East Counties Country Schools)

Miss. Bronwyn (Bron) Clegg Year 6

These students are preparing themselves for their Intermediate years at Hunua School.

As well as having fun learning, they will develop independent and reflective work habits. Over the year they will find new ways to learn, guided by a teacher experienced in both primary and Intermediate school teaching.

INTERMEDIATE Year 7&8

Mr. Nick Gage DP (Deputy Principal)

For the first time the Year 7&8 students will have the opportunity to wear their Intermediate uniform. This will be phased in over the course of the year. Guided by an experienced Intermediate school teacher the students will learn in a digital classroom. They will continue to be provided with the experience, curriculum and opportunities that New Zealand Intermediate students receive ... and more!!!
