



Kia Ora to our Purapura parents and whānau,

Highlights of our week include:

- **Uniforms:** Please ensure correct school uniform is being worn by your child/ren, including school hats, black socks and black shoes. Red or black thermals can be worn in these colder months. If children want to play on the field the rest of this term it is compulsory they have a change of clothes in their bag. **NAME ALL UNIFORMS/CLOTHING.** A note from home is required when non-uniform clothing is worn to school. The children are not permitted to wear jewellery to school.
- **Behaviour Notices:** Behaviour notices are part of our PB4L (Positive Behaviour for Learning) reward and consequence programme that we embrace at Hunua School and that all teachers and students adhere to across the entire school from year 0-8. These are entered into a programme and monitored to ensure there are no ongoing patterns. On the other side when good examples happen we give RiCH tokens, celebrate and always share why they are given. Parents are not necessarily notified about incidents unless classified as a "Major" this could be anything from inappropriate physical abuse to unacceptable verbal language or regular patterns that are possibly forming. Our RiCH (Respect, Caring and Honesty) values are taught specifically every Wednesday with a weekly focus that is talked about on a regular basis in Purapura.
- **Book Bags:** Please send these to school everyday. They should contain readers, poem book, Kluwell book, 2 maths worksheets, library book.
- **Spelling:** These lists are in the back of your child's Poem books. Children do need to practice reading and writing these high frequency words so that in time they are recognised and recalled instantly. Students need to get these words correct 3 times consecutively to move to the next level. We monitor this. If your child does not bring their poetry book to school we can not mark their spelling.
- **Ag-Day:** Everyone should know now that Ag Day is a compulsory day at Hunua School. All children are expected to participate and attend this amazing day on Sat 28 October. It would be helpful to know what project your child will be doing so that we can ensure each child goes to their correct project talk on Wednesday 5 July. Please indicate by writing your child's name and the corresponding letter beside your choice of project:
