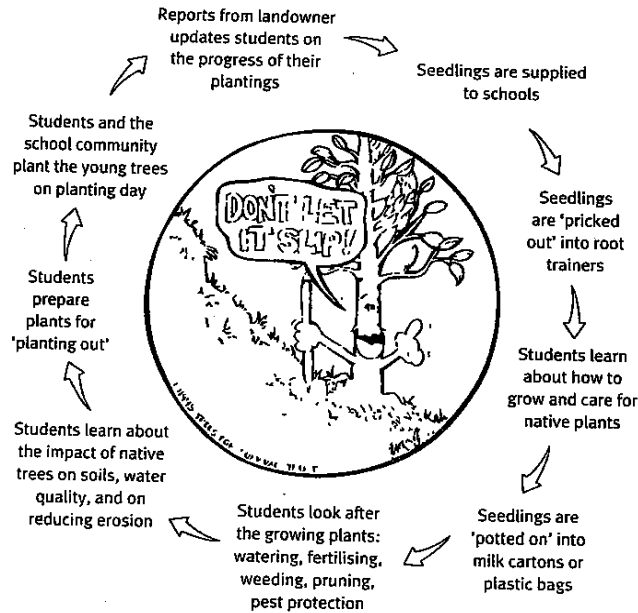
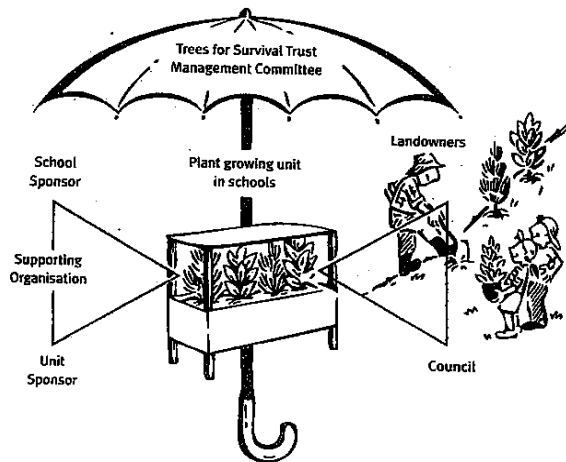


The Trees for Survival Learning Cycle

Steps to becoming a TFS school

1. The School Board applies to incorporate the TFS programme into their school environmental education curriculum.
2. The TFS National Committee receives and approves the application pending appropriate funding arrangements being made and a commitment to the programme being made by the School Board.
3. The school and TFS work together to arrange funding to cover the Annual Fee and/or Plant Growing Unit from one or more supporting organisations.
4. An appropriate and secure location for the PGU is established at the school and the school arranges appropriate insurance against damage by vandalism.
5. The supply of seedlings, materials and availability of resource personnel is arranged.

The time from receipt of the application until installation of a PGU and implementation of the programme can take up to three months.
