Homework:

SPELLING: The essential list (we used in Term 4, 2017) are still current for this term. I aim to have a spelling check in during week 5.

READING: Room 4 are on they way to read for 100 nights. The children are to read and record what they have read. Could the parents please sign the reading log. This helps to keep track.

MATH: During the week, room 4 set up their number knowledge books. The children will bring these home on Monday night. The aim is to know all of the steps before the end of the year. Some are easy, some are not! I have a record of the steps the children already know. We will have check ins on the odd weeks. This will be a one to one to track learning of number knowledge.

The Week That Was:

- Room 4 focus word is “stamina” This is The ability to sustain prolonged physical or mental effort. Their secret is stamina rather than speed. Rowing is ideal for building stamina.



- RiCH. Respect. Respect for self, respect for other, respect for adults, as we make the most of our learning time. We can use our learning buddies, learning conversations and “C 3 B4 Me (the adult)”
- Te Reo Maori. We have started to learn about our Mihi.
- Writing. Instructions! We learnt that these need to be very specific and in order. Especially if we are brushing our teeth.
- Literacy (reading and word work). We are settling into our reading and word work times better. Next week we look forward to putting the two together in one session.
- Maths. Probability. We continued to learn about probability, especially ‘fair’ while playing card games.
- Reading; Reading to someone, Reading to self, and Listening to reading (while we finish some colouring in work)
