Mid-year Reports & Parent Interviews: The most Important EVER!

We have so much to learn from everyone's experiences, in regard to student learning, during lockdown. We don't want to miss the opportunity. In the last week of this term you will receive a copy of the post COVID-19 lockdown report. This report is like no other:

- ◇ Part 1 is written by the teacher. It is a judgement of your child's achievement in reading, writing & maths **prior** to lockdown. The teacher may comment on effort and attitude, or perhaps how ready for learning your child was. They may comment on specific work, including group work. There may even be mention of how well your child has remembered work.
- ◇ Part 2 is all about you, the parent. Thoughts you had about your child and the way they learn. You may have questions you want to ask the teacher. You may have found that your child worked best in the middle of the morning after they had been for a run around the house. Maybe they learnt best from experiencing things outside. Jot down your ideas in the boxes.
- ◇ Part 3 Your child will share their reflection on lockdown.
- ◇ Part 4 Time for goal setting for reading, writing & maths. This will be done together - parent, student, teacher - and will guide the work for the rest of 2020.

When you get the report ... read the teachers comments ... jot down your ideas ... come to the interview to share your ideas and work together to set goals.

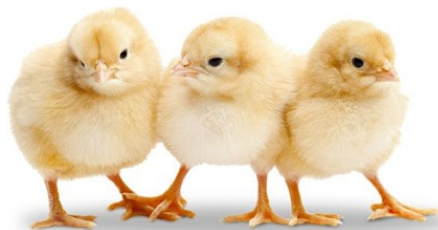
PTA SAUSAGE SIZZLE RETURNS
